

Evaluation **SYSTEM**



Conducting of assessments is the most fecund way to judge the progress of the students. The significance of exams is on the rise in today's result oriented world. For this purpose, Academy conducts 3 terminal exams for both the years. On the basis of the course covered up to the respective terminal exam the question papers are set on the NCERT pattern. Besides after the completion of each unit the concerned teacher prepares MCQs to familiarize the students with entrance type MCQs. Moreover, daily practice papers prepared by the teachers of the Academy are supplied to the students for group study which boost the self-confidence as self-learning skills. Along with that every fort night mock tests are also conducted to prepare the students for various entrance examinations.









Academy FREE SEATS

With every passing day the cost of living is hiking ceaselessly and it is becoming difficult for the people to meet their ends. Providing quality education to the children becomes impossible to many people. But Salt Brook never allows the people to get shattered to dust. Within its limitations, the academy provides an opportunity to the economically weak meritorious students to materialise their dreams. Salt Brook offers a total of 14 free seats- 10 in science stream, 2 in Arts stream and 2 in commerce stream. Minimum percentage to avail this opportunity is 80. Candidates are selected on the merit basis. The merit of the students selected for the free seats will immediately be verified after the admission and if any anomalies found the student has to forfeit the free seat. Salt Brook bears all the needed expenditures such as College tuition fees, Hostel fees, Books and Uniforms.

AMRITA DOWERAH SCHOLARSHIP







► Year wise 1st and 2nd Division Percentage of Students
















 Any student absent continuously for more than 3 (three) days, without valid reason, might be given Transfer Certificate.
